

# John 1:14-18 Part I

## Behold the Glory of the Word Made Flesh

### 1. 'And The Word Became Flesh': (14a)

- a. Not an \_\_\_\_\_ to His full deity. –*John 20:28; Rom 9:5*
- b. But the permanent \_\_\_\_\_ of full humanity. –*Rom 1:3-4*

### 2. 'And Dwelt Among Us': (14b)

- a. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ among us:

### 3. 'And We Have Seen His glory: (14c)

- a. As Moses saw some of God's glory at the giving of the Law:

  - iii. Glory most fully seen in God's \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ revealed at the cross. –*John 12:23; 17:1; Is 53:6-11; Col 2:13-14; Heb 12:2*

## John 1:14-18

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. <sup>15</sup> (John bore witness about him, and cried out, "This was he of whom I said, 'He who comes after me ranks before me, because he was before me.'") <sup>16</sup> For from his fullness we have all received, grace upon grace. <sup>17</sup> For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. <sup>18</sup> No one has ever seen God; the only God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known.
