Graduates – Please pray for our high school graduates, Haley Meyer, Jordan Petersen, and Madi Sweet, as they seek to follow God's direction for school and career.

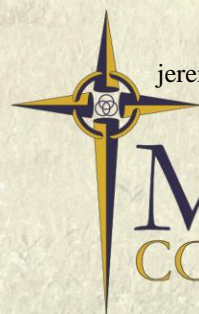
