## Seeing and Savoring God's Word

### 1. Seeing the \_\_\_\_\_ of God's Word: (97-102)

- a. His \_\_\_\_\_ of God's Word: (97)
  - i. \_\_\_\_\_: 'Oh how I love your Law!' –vs. 163-165
  - ii. \_\_\_\_\_: 'It is my meditation all the day.' –Ps 2:1-2; Deut 6:4
- b. His \_\_\_\_\_ from God's Word: (98-100)
  - i. 'Your commandment makes me wiser than my **enemies**, for it is ever with me.' –Deut 6:4
  - ii. 'I have more understanding than all my **teachers**, for your testimonies are my meditation.' –v. 97
  - iii. 'I understand more than the **aged**, for I keep your precepts.' –v. 27
- c. His \_\_\_\_\_ of God's Word: (101-102)
  - i. 'I hold back my feet from every evil way, in order to keep your word.' –Prov 1:15
  - ii. 'I do not turn aside from your rules, for you have taught me.' –v. 68

### 2. Savoring the \_\_\_\_\_ of God's Word: (103-104)

- a. His \_\_\_\_\_ with God's Word: (103)
  - i. \_\_\_\_\_: 'How sweet are your words to my taste,' –1 Pet 2:3
  - ii. \_\_\_\_\_: 'Sweeter than honey to my mouth!' –Ps 19:10
- b. His \_\_\_\_\_ from God's Word: (104)
  - i. \_\_\_\_\_: 'Through your precepts I get understanding,' –v. 34
  - ii. \_\_\_\_\_: 'therefore I hate every false way.' –Ps 5:5; Prov 8:13

### 3. Seeking in the \_\_\_\_\_ of God's Word:

- a. Know: it is critical that you \_\_\_\_\_ in God's Word. –2 Thes 2:10
- b. Ask: the Lord to \_\_\_\_\_ your \_\_\_\_\_ to the glories of His Word. –v. 18
- c. Be: regularly and prayerfully \_\_\_\_\_ upon His Word. –2 Pet 2:1-3
- d. Strive: to \_\_\_\_\_ His Word. –John 13:17
