

# John 4:45-54

## Jesus Heals the Nobleman's Son

### 1. Jesus Arrives in Galilee: (45-46)

- a. The Galileans give Jesus A \_\_\_\_\_ welcome:
  - i. *"So when he came to Galilee..."* –John 4:44; Mk 1:14
  - ii. *'Having seen all that he had done in Jerusalem...'* –John 2:23-25
- b. Jesus returns to Cana:
  - i. Where He had performed His \_\_\_\_\_ sign. –John 2:1-11
  - ii. *'At Capernaum there was an official whose son was ill.'* –John 2:12

### 2. An Urgent Plea and Strong Rebuke: (47-48)

- a. He was \_\_\_\_\_ with Jesus to come down and heal his son:
  - i. He wanted Jesus to go to his son and heal him. –John 2:12
  - ii. His son was at the point of death. –Lk 7:1-9
- b. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ the Galileans to the noble man:
  - i. *'Unless you \_\_\_\_\_ see signs and wonders you will not believe.'*  
–John 2:18; 5:36; 6:30; 12:37
  - ii. His rebuke served as a \_\_\_\_\_ to the noble man. –John 2:35
- c. The noble \_\_\_\_\_: *'Come down before my child dies!'* –John 11:21

### 3. A Gracious Gift and a Growing Faith: (49-54)

- a. *Jesus said to him, 'Go; your son will live.'*
  - i. No \_\_\_\_\_ given other than Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_. –John 4:41-42
  - ii. Jesus grants his desire but not his specific \_\_\_\_\_. –John 4:47
- b. The man believed Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_ and went home:
  - i. He believed \_\_\_\_\_ needing a sign. –John 20:29
  - ii. He trusted Jesus' word and \_\_\_\_\_ upon it. –John 3:36
- c. The man's faith \_\_\_\_\_:
  - i. His faith \_\_\_\_\_ when the healing was confirmed. –John 2:11
  - ii. He \_\_\_\_\_ to his family about Jesus. –John 4:39
- d. *'This was now the second sign that Jesus had done..'* –John 2:11

# John 4:45-54

<sup>45</sup> So when he came to Galilee, the Galileans welcomed him, having seen all that he had done in Jerusalem at the feast. For they too had gone to the feast.

<sup>46</sup> So he came again to Cana in Galilee, where he had made the water wine. And at Capernaum there was an official whose son was ill. <sup>47</sup> When this man heard that Jesus had come from Judea to Galilee, he went to him and asked him to come down and heal his son, for he was at the point of death. <sup>48</sup> So Jesus said to him, "Unless you see signs and wonders you will not believe." <sup>49</sup> The official said to him, "Sir, come down before my child dies." <sup>50</sup> Jesus said to him, "Go; your son will live." The man believed the word that Jesus spoke to him and went on his way. <sup>51</sup> As he was going down, his servants met him and told him that his son was recovering. <sup>52</sup> So he asked them the hour when he began to get better, and they said to him, "Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him." <sup>53</sup> The father knew that was the hour when Jesus had said to him, "Your son will live." And he himself believed, and all his household. <sup>54</sup> This was now the second sign that Jesus did when he had come from Judea to Galilee.
