

## Psalm 5:1-12

### Deliver Me O God of Justice and Grace!

#### 1. David Trusts in the LORD's \_\_\_\_\_: (1-3)

- a. His \_\_\_\_\_: likely written during Absalom's coup. –2 Sam 15-17
- b. His \_\_\_\_\_ for the LORD's attention:
  - i. Repetition: 'Give ear to', 'consider', 'give attention to.' –Ps 1:2; 39:3
  - ii. Supplication: King David has a \_\_\_\_\_. –Ps 2:6
- c. His \_\_\_\_\_ in the Lord's response:
  - i. In the morning the Lord will hear. –Ps 88:13; 119:147; 130:6
  - ii. In the morning David will prepare and watch. –Ex 29:38-42; Ps 4:8

#### 2. David Recounts the LORD's \_\_\_\_\_: (4-6)

- a. Evil may not \_\_\_\_\_ with the LORD. –James 1:13; 1 John 1:5
- b. He \_\_\_\_\_ all evildoers. –Ps 11:5; 97:10; Prov 6:16-19
- c. He abhors and \_\_\_\_\_ the bloodthirsty and deceitful. –Ps 55:23

#### 3. David Depends Upon the LORD's \_\_\_\_\_: (7-8)

- a. He counts upon God's \_\_\_\_\_ . –Ex 34:6-7; 2 Sam 12:13
- b. He \_\_\_\_\_ enter God's house. –1 Sam 1:9; 3:3; 15:25; 1 Kgs 8:29
- c. But he desperately needs God's \_\_\_\_\_ to do so. –Ps 23:3-4

#### 4. David Calls Upon the LORD's \_\_\_\_\_: (9-10)

- a. \_\_\_\_\_: He recounts his enemies' guilt. –Rom 3:13
- b. \_\_\_\_\_: expose, ensnare, and expel them. –2 Sam 15:31
  - i. He is not being a self-righteous \_\_\_\_\_. –Matt 18:23-35
  - ii. He is trusting in God's \_\_\_\_\_ and not his own. –2 Sam 16:5-14

#### 5. David Rejoices in the LORD's \_\_\_\_\_: (11-12)

- a. David invites \_\_\_\_\_ to rejoice with him. –Ps 40:16; 70:4
- b. Individual \_\_\_\_\_ is meant to create corporate \_\_\_\_\_. –Ps 34:1-8
- c. Individual acts of deliverance \_\_\_\_\_ us all who our God is. –Ps 77
- d. God \_\_\_\_\_ the righteous with His protective favor. –1 Sam 23:26

## Psalm 5

*A Psalm of David.*

- Give ear to my words, O LORD;  
consider my groaning.
- <sup>2</sup> Give attention to the sound of my cry,  
my King and my God,  
for to you do I pray.
- <sup>3</sup> O LORD, in the morning you hear my voice;  
in the morning I prepare a sacrifice for you and watch.
- <sup>4</sup> For you are not a God who delights in wickedness;  
evil may not dwell with you.
- <sup>5</sup> The boastful shall not stand before your eyes;  
you hate all evildoers.
- <sup>6</sup> You destroy those who speak lies;  
the LORD abhors the bloodthirsty and deceitful man.
- <sup>7</sup> But I, through the abundance of your steadfast love,  
will enter your house.  
I will bow down toward your holy temple  
in the fear of you.
- <sup>8</sup> Lead me, O LORD, in your righteousness  
because of my enemies;  
make your way straight before me.
- <sup>9</sup> For there is no truth in their mouth;  
their inmost self is destruction;  
their throat is an open grave;  
they flatter with their tongue.
- <sup>10</sup> Make them bear their guilt, O God;  
let them fall by their own counsels;  
because of the abundance of their transgressions cast them out,  
for they have rebelled against you.
- <sup>11</sup> But let all who take refuge in you rejoice;  
let them ever sing for joy,  
and spread your protection over them,  
that those who love your name may exult in you.
- <sup>12</sup> For you bless the righteous, O LORD;  
you cover him with favor as with a shield.  
*To the choirmaster: with stringed instruments; according to The Sheminith.*
